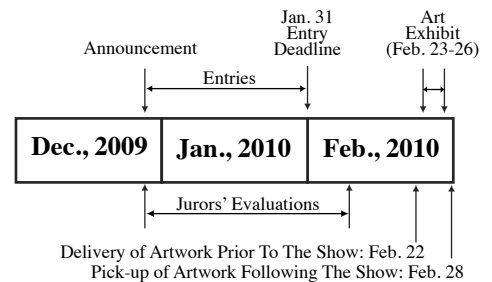

— GNA ART EXHIBIT RULES AND REGULATIONS —

JURORS

A jury of knowledgeable individuals will evaluate candidate work and make the selections. The jury has the final word on acceptances and rejections. For rejected work, the entry fee will be returned. Try again.

ENTRY FEE

Entry fees are \$15 for GNA members and \$25 for non-GNA members. College students are free. Fees will be submitted along with the application and are refundable (in the event that an applicant's work is rejected). A single fee covers the entry for 1 or more than 1 item.

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK PRIOR TO THE SHOW

Artists must deliver work to The National Arts Club on Monday morning, Feb. 22, 2010, from 9 a.m. until noon. Please come closer to 9 a.m.

PICK-UP OF ARTWORK FOLLOWING THE SHOW

Artists must pick up their work on Sunday morning, Feb. 28, 2010, from 9 a.m. until noon. Please come closer to 9 a.m.

ARTWORK READY FOR DISPLAY

All accepted work must be ready to hang at the exhibit.

PROPER IDENTIFICATION OF THE ARTWORK

Artists must identify their work with their names and addresses affixed on the back side of each piece. Include phone number and price if the work is for sale.

FOR SALE OR NOT FOR SALE

Artists may offer their pieces for sale. The full value of the sale goes to the artist.

It is the artist's responsibility to collect New York State Sales tax (8.375%) from the buyer.

It is the artist's responsibility to make arrangements with the buyer for payment and delivery. Sold art will remain on display for the duration of the show.

SHOW DATES & OPENING

The show dates are Tuesday, February 23 through Friday, February 26, 2010. Hours are 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. A reception will be held on Tuesday evening, February 23, from 6-8 p.m.

SIZES AND NUMBER OF PIECES

Maximum size is 32"x32" frame size or 1024 square inches. As for multiple pieces or unusual dimensions, the jurors will decide what can or cannot be accommodated.

APPLICATION with IMAGES

In addition to completing the form and submitting the fee, applicants must provide imaging material for the jury. This may be a digital file, a slide, or a print of the artwork along with a description of the size and other pertinent factors. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you want this material returned to you.

ELIGIBILITY

Submissions must be the entrant's own work. The entrant must be first-year college or older.

LIABILITY

Neither the GNA nor the National Arts Club will be held responsible for lost or damage of any kind while the art is displayed at the GNA Art Show.
